Douglas Fisher, Ph.D., has published numerous articles on reading and literacy, differentiated instruction, and curriculum design as well as books, including *Creating Literacy-Rich Schools for Adolescents* (with Gay Ivey) and *Improving Adolescent Literacy: Strategies at Work* (with Nancy Frey).

Nancy Frey, Ph.D., has coauthored several books on literacy, including *Language Arts Workshop: Purposeful Reading and Writing Instruction* and *Reading for Information in Elementary School* (both with Doug Fisher).

Marcia Invernizzi, Ph.D., is a professor of reading education at the Curry School of Education at the University of Virginia. She teaches the clinical practice of reading diagnosis and remedial reading. She is best known for her co-authored series *Words Their Way*.
